CHANGE: Division Change option

The “Change” option to switch the current Division has been moved closer to the Division name along the top of every screen, for the purposes of clarity.

New: iPad layout support

The application has been optimized for iPad. This includes the ability to rotate the view between horizontal and vertical orientation as well as side-by-side views of Work results. This enables you to view your Work list to the left and the details of the selected Work record to the right.

New: Status Control Panel graphics

If the Status Control Panel is enabled for a user, they will see their search results represented in a similar view from this app. This view has been optimized for larger screens to include a graphical representation of the data which appears next to the Status Control Panel.

CHANGE: Multi-line display field

When you click on a multiline field to view it in full, the window that appears in the foreground will now have a thin border to help distinguish it from the background. Clicking anywhere in this box will close it.

CHANGE: Relative date search options

When defining a date range for a search, you now have the following additional options: Last 60 days, Last 30 days, Next 30 days, Next 60 days

NEW: Persistent Fields

The application will now support mobile fields marked as persistent. Any persistent field will retain its value each time a user submits a new Work record. The persistent value is set the first time a user enters a Work record, and it will retain that value until the user changes it (or they sign out of the application).

NEW: View Readings

When viewing a Work record linked to Readings, you will now see an option to view and edit those Readings. Clicking on the Readings icon will open up a list view of all linked Readings. Press Edit to update the *Value* and *Notes* for each Reading.

NEW: View Tasks

When viewing a Work record linked to Tasks, you will now see an option to view those tasks. Clicking on the Tasks icon will open up a list view of all linked Tasks. Clicking on an individual task will display its entire Notes; click anywhere in the text window to close it and return to the list.
