


The universal installer is built to be Mac-friendly. You can access this installer file from any Mac with an internet connection.

### Installing the Files


1. In Safari, go to your installer link (<https://clientname.amjxt.com/AMJXTInstaller.jar>). This will automatically begin the program download.
2. Once the download has completed, go to your **Downloads** folder and double-click the file to open it. The following message will appear:



3. Click **Open**. The installation wizard will pop up, displaying a screen that looks like this:




- Click **Next**. The installation wizard will ask you to choose a target path. You can leave the default path if you wish, or choose a new location for the installer package.




**Note:** The default path will drop the files in your user directory under a folder named “AMJXT” (/Users/*YourUsername*/AMJXT).

- Once you have chosen a file path, click **Next** again. If you have named a location that does not already exist, you may see a dialog informing you that the directory has been created.
- The next screen will install the files and inform you when the installation is complete. Once the installation progress bar reads “Finished,” click **Next**.




7. You should see a screen informing you that the installation is finished and that an uninstaller has also been created. Click **Done**.




**Opening the Database**

**Note:** These instructions are for users who chose the default directory during installation. If you chose another directory, open Finder and navigate to the directory you chose.


1. Open Finder.
2. In the **Go** menu at the top of the page, choose **Computer**.




3. In the window that opens, double-click the icon titled **Macintosh HD**.




- In the window that opens, double-click the folder titled **Users**.




- In the Users folder, find the folder with your username. This folder may have an icon that looks like a house. Double-click it.



- In the window that opens, double-click the folder titled **AMJXT**.



- In the window that opens, you should see a file named **AMJXTClient.jar**. Double-click this file to launch the database.



That's it!

**Tip:** Want to be able to access the database more easily, and with less navigation? Drag the file to your dock and pin it! Then you can access the system from your desktop for future launches, without any additional navigation.
